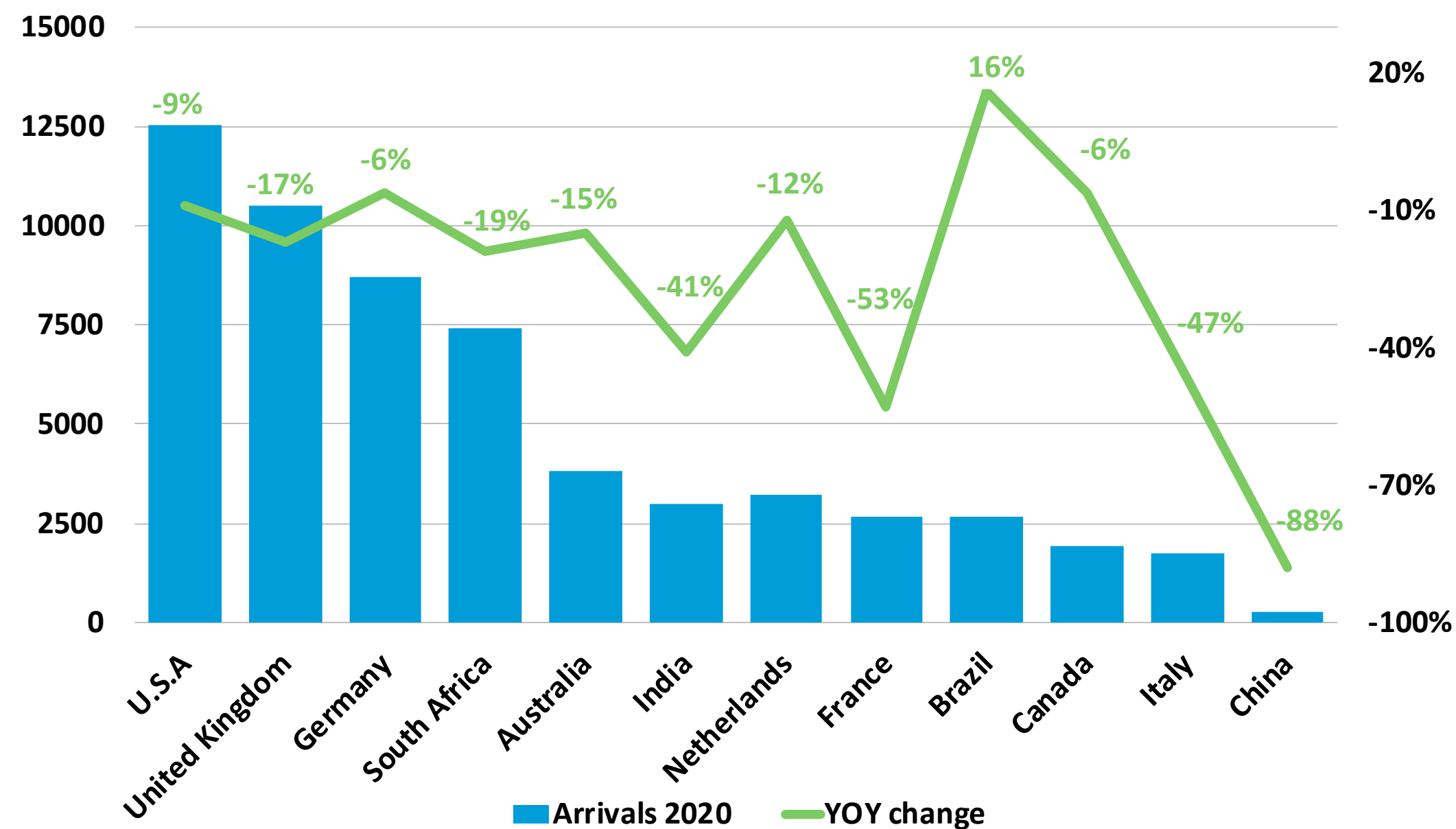

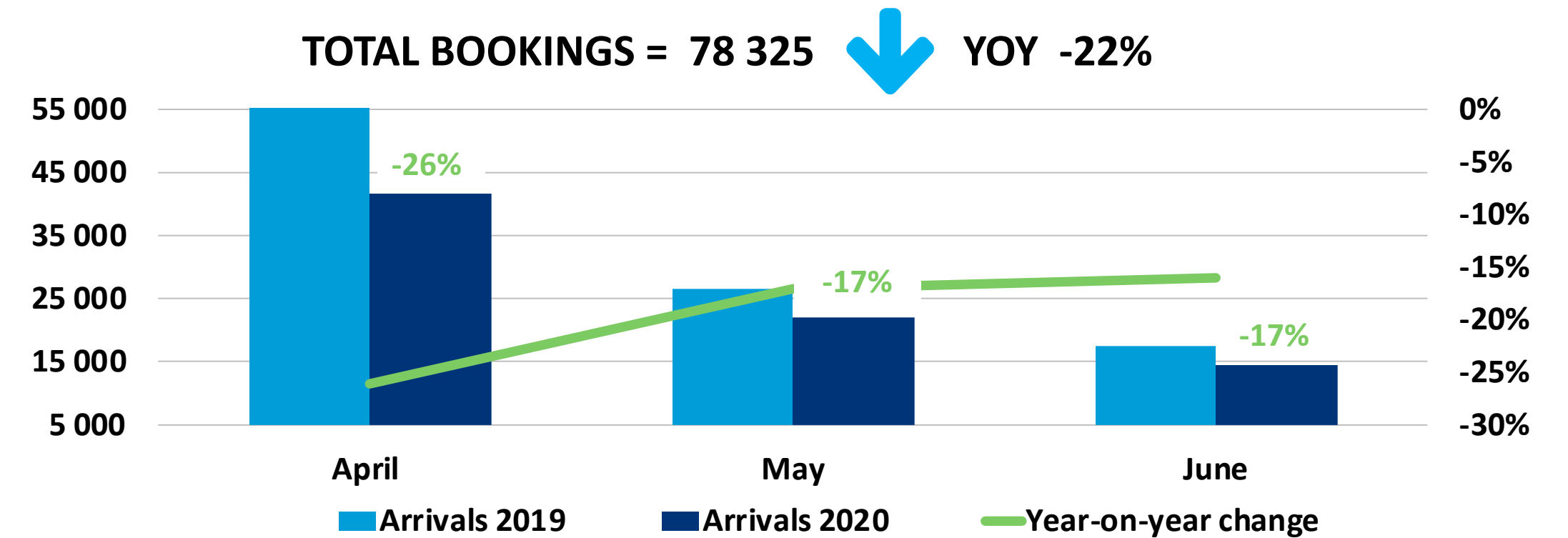
Banned access from countries to South Africa include: China, Germany, Italy, Iran, South Korea, Spain, United Kingdom and U.S.A
